Policy Name: Referee Uniform Dress Policy

Purpose: The aim of the policy is to encourage you to better understand your responsibilities as Dandenong Referees and to enable you to strive to set the best standards of conduct for other referees in the state of Victoria and elsewhere to follow.

Policy:

All referees will be expected to adhere to this policy whenever officiating in competitions under the control of the Dandenong Basketball Association (DBA) or competitions that DBA are responsible for supplying referees to.

All Finals

For Semi Finals, Preliminary Finals and Grand finals it is a requirement of the appointment that long black slacks are worn. You will be replaced on games if this is not adhered to.

Winter Uniform (Winter season and all VJBL Competitions):

- Approved Black and White referee shirt or Green shirt (learner/ apprentice)
- Black slacks
- Black belt (non branded, if required)
- Black socks
- Predominantly Black Sports Shoes with non-marking soles.
- Approved VBRA Dandenong Branch Jacket

Summer Uniform (Summer Season)

- Approved Black and White referee shirt or Green shirt (learner/ apprentice)
- Plain Black Basketball Shorts. (Not to extend below the knee or be shorter than 100mm above the knee)
- Black or White Sports Socks
- Black or white Sports shoes

(Winter uniform can be worn in Summer but NOT vice versa)

Whenever the Referee Shirt is visible it must be “tucked in”.

Referees will be given an opportunity by Supervisors to purchase the required uniform or rectify the problem prior to issuing any penalty.

Failure to comply with Uniform Policy will be managed under the Discipline Policy (Dec 14).
